Philippians 3:7-12

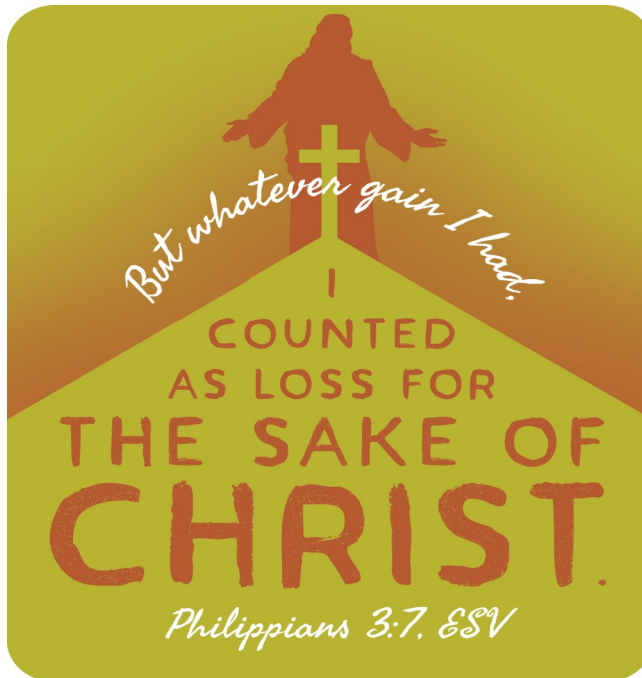
*Paul's encounter with the living Christ transformed his life.

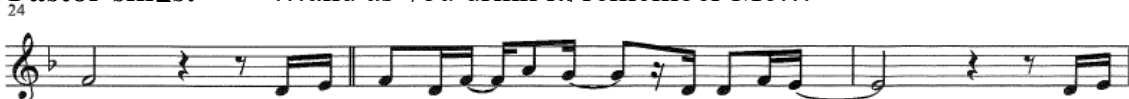

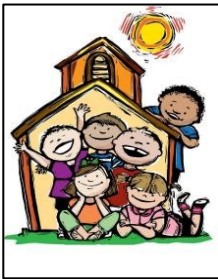
