

Amen.







THE LORD'S PRAYER


Gathered into one by the Holy Spirit, let us pray as Jesus taught us,





All are invited to light a candle, the first person in each row taking a light from the usher and then passing it on to the person next to you. The lighted candle is not tilted. It is always held upright when giving light to another. **Candles are to continue shining through the Benediction.**




