## From the Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Knowing life was soon to become sad and complicated, before His last supper, Jesus spoke these words of strength and comfort to His disciples.

*Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled, and do not let them be afraid. (John 14:27)*

It feels weird writing this letter as we begin our journey with Jesus through Holy Week and the cross. You'll be receiving the Visitor just in time for Easter. It's so tempting to forgo all the pain and suffering of the Passion and jump right to Easter. He is risen!

Life doesn't work that way, though, does it? Sometimes, in the challenges, pain, and suffering in our lives, it's hard to conceive of peace and an untroubled heart. Many of us are grieving loved ones; there's an empty chair at the table for Easter dinner this year. We've received bad news from the doctor, lost jobs, or important relationships. Life is HARD!!!

Yet, Jesus promises peace – not as the world gives – but peace that God provides. The peace Jesus talks about isn't that sense of contentment that settles in when life is comfortable. No, this peace is calm in the middle of chaos swirling around us.

God's peace doesn't ignore fear and anxiety. Instead, peace names the fear and allows us to feel it fully. Then, we lean into God's love and the fear loses its power to control us. We're free to respond to tough situations in new and creative ways.

Holy Week we'll walk with Jesus to the cross. In His suffering and death, Jesus shows His complete solidarity with our suffering. Jesus understands betrayal, pain, and death. He completely trusts God as He walks that path to Calvary. He opens His arms and gives Himself totally. And the world weeps thinking it's all over.

It isn't. God loves you! Jesus' victory over death and evil comes three days later. He is raised from the dead and that promise is yours as well. This new life is something we experience NOW, TODAY, not just at the end of life when we transition to the arms of God. God is active TODAY in your life bringing new possibility and resurrection from the ashes of defeat.

The gift is we are not alone in this thing we call life. God walks with us through every circumstance in our lives. It is that promise that brings peace in the midst of chaos.

- Council is encouraged to attend the services during Holy Week to truly get the meaning of the Journey to the Cross and the glory of the resurrection.

- Homeless connection is in need of Dishes, pots, pans, silverware and other household items
- Daffodils for Meals on Wheels will be delivered to First Lutheran Church on Monday, March 22
- The UCCA meeting will be held on March 21<sup>st</sup> at Trinity in the Social Hall. There will be at least 3 Easter Sunrise Services in the community

- Council Nominating Committee is asking for anyone who feels called to be on Council to please contact any Council member to let them know of their interest. We will need to know by May at the latest.
- \$4,000 will be divided amongst the scholarship applicants this year

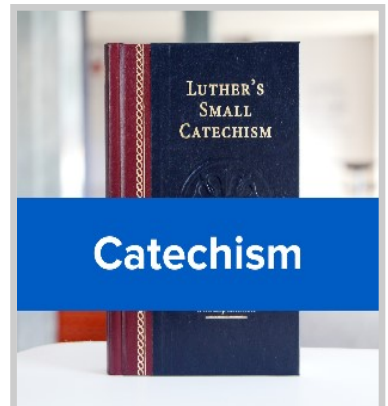
## A SPIRITUAL DIRECTION BOOK CLUB

The Sewing Group meets once a month usually on the last Wednesday of the month at different members' homes. We mainly work on our own projects but also have worked on Trinity projects.

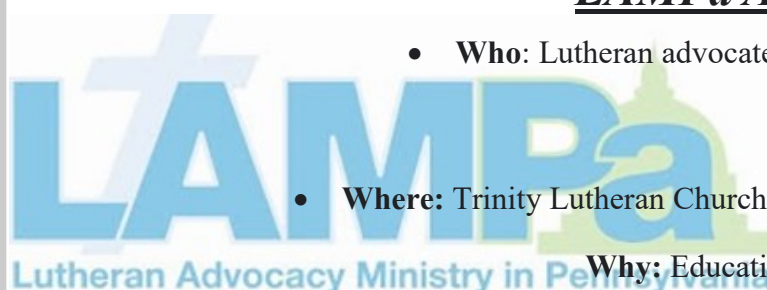
Every year we make the stoles for those finishing Confirmation.

Estimates of Giving are a valuable resource for Support Committee, so that they can create a meaningful budget. It is also a great resource for the giving unit. The EOV provide the giving unit a goal of giving and helps the member(s) prepare their personal budget of income and expenses for the coming year, and to set aside a proportion for the Lord. Trinity encourages proportional giving ( a percentage of God's gifts to you) of your income and if possible to increase that proportion annually.

We give, not out of obligation, but cheerfully. God loves a cheerful giver.

Each giving unit – husband and wife or single confirmed member – has received a packet. Trinity has 289 giving units. Two couples in the congregation are challenging each of you to return your completed Estimate of Giving. They will make a gift of \$8,000.00 if 100 Estimates of Giving are received by April 21. You are invited on April 14 or 21 to present your offering, Estimate of Giving, and Time and Talent to the Lord during the offertory.
